Contact Information

Can we remind parents/carers that it is your responsibility to inform the school office straight away of any change of contact details. This can be easily done through our Parents' app.

For example: Mobile numbers/change of address/emergency contact.

If your child becomes ill throughout the school day it is important that we are able to contact a family member straight away as it is not nice for children to be ill at school.



Health Reminders

Sickness and Diarrhoea

If your child has sickness and diarrhea, please do not send them to school but do let us know via the app. Please can you also ensure that they remain away from school for 24 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhea.

Medical appointments

If your child has a medical appointment e.g. at the doctors, dentist or hospital, please inform school via the app (a photo can also be uploaded of the text message or appointment card) so that the absence can be recorded in the register as a medical appointment. If you do not have a letter or appointment card because the appointment has been made over the phone, usually you are sent a text to remind you and again a screen shot of this can be uploaded via the absence reporting through the app and we will also use medication given as proof.

Please do not be offended when asked for proof. Our practices are in line with recommendations from our Education Welfare Officer and all parents are treated similarly.

Appropriate Dress

Now that the weather is starting to deteriorate, and experiencing cold, ice and snow, please ensure that your child comes to school with a suitable warm coat and clothing.

Even if it seems fine when the children set off to school in the morning, it can be cold and damp by lunchtime. If it is cold outside, to safeguard our children's welfare, we do not let children go out to play if they have not brought a coat to school.

Please can you also ensure that your child has strong shoes that are weatherproof when coming to school. They spend time playing with the playground equipment and therefore need suitable footwear.
